Facilitate cultural and linguistic competency strategies throughout Indiana's state and local systems to improve outcomes for populations vulnerable to disparities and disproportionalities.




What is organizational adaptability?

 - Organizational Psychology
 - Sociology
- Its primary Call to Action:
 - The study of strategy versus execution
 - The study of relationship between organizations and their environments
 - > They study of organizations, populations and organizations, and organizational fields
